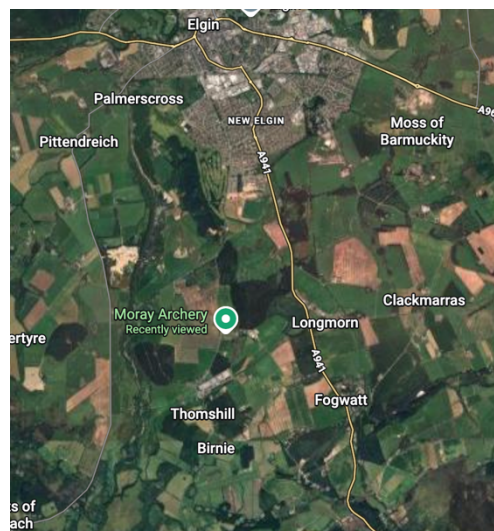

The schedule will be available on lanseo along with the other tournament documentation. Please be aware that this schedule is subject to change and any major scheduling changes will be communicated to all athletes (via your team manager) as soon as possible.

It is hoped that each area will be able to submit a full team for each bowstyle:
(3 RO, 3 RW, 3 CO, 3 CW, 3 BO, 3 BW, 3 LO, 3 LW).

There will be three passes of round robin matches, therefore each area will have a bye round. This bye round is NOT to be scored. Only the matches shot against other areas will be used to calculate the area winners.

Bosses

Layered foam bosses or Damage bosses on H frames will be used.

Dress Code

Archers and other team officials (coaches, team managers etc...) must comply with Archery GB dress regulations (Rule 307).

Photography

In view of the provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults policy, those who wish to take videos or photographs at this event are asked to register their details online via the QR code displayed.

If parents/carers have any concerns about their child or young person being photographed or filmed, they should inform the Competition Manager.

This year, a QR code will be displayed around the venue for you to submit your details to take photographs instead of the written paper version previously used.

Anti-Doping

Archers competing at the tournament may be asked to provide a sample for anti-doping and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to be tested will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries (under 18) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, who must give consent for anti-doping test to be conducted, if approached.

Data Protection

When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with Tournament Organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth/Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.

Divisions

This year there will be two divisions that an athlete can enter. These being Women and Open.

Female Category: This category is for those participants recorded female at birth.

Open Category: This category is open to all including those participants recorded male at birth, recorded female at birth (regardless of whether they have undergone hormone therapy), and those who identify as transgender or non-binary.

Competition Documentation

All documentation will be published on lanseo, the Scottish Archery website and to all team managers via WhatsApp.

The entrants list will be updated weekly and will be available on lanseo, please let the Competition Manager know if there are any mistakes.

Scoring / Results

Double scoring will be used throughout the weekend. There will be one paper scorecard and one electronic PDA.

Live scoring will be used and results published to lanseo. Full championship results will be published after the completion of the competition.

Smoking
